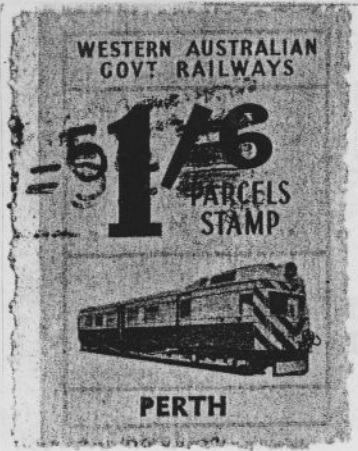
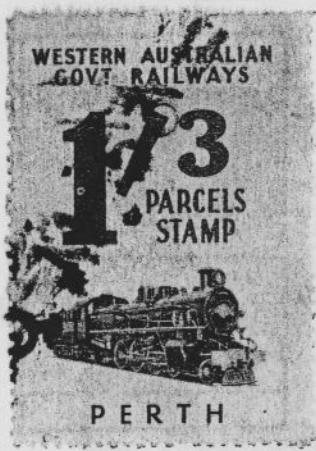


Conditions. (1) All bids shall be made in Australian dollars, buy bids will not be accepted. (2) The highest bidder shall be the purchaser. Where only one bid is received on a particular lot it will be sold at the reserve indicated. Where more than one bid is received for a particular lot the purchase price shall be approximately 5% above the second highest bid received. In the case of equal bids the lot shall be sold to the first bid received. (3) Payment is due within 7 days of receipt of invoice and should be made payable to the Western Australia Study Group and must be in Australian dollars. (4) Purchasers may reject any lot that is not as described in the catalogue provided the lot is returned to the Western Australia Study Group within 10 days of posting for purchasers within Australia and within 30 days for overseas purchasers. (5) Every effort is made to ensure that descriptions are accurate but neither the Western Australia Study Group nor its officers or agents accept any responsibility in respect of the accuracy of the descriptions or valuations in the catalogue. (6) Only members of the Western Australia Study Group are eligible to bid. (7) Vendors will be charged a commission of 10% (members of WASG) or 15% (non-members of WASG). There is no buyers' commission. (8) **POSTING in Australia.** Registered POST is \$1-90 per article plus postage. It offers insurance to \$100 with additional available at \$1-05 per \$100 or part thereof in excess of \$100 up to \$5000. Delivery Confirmation costs \$1-65 and PERSON to PERSON costs \$5-00. **POSTING International.** All letter mail now by air. Registered Post International available only in Prepaid Envelopes, (small) maximum 500g, cost \$9-00; and (large) maximum 500g, cost \$15-00. Compensation up to \$100 is at Australia Post's discretion. International INSURANCE is not available with Registered Post International. Canada and the USA do not accept insurance, but most other countries do at a cost of \$5 plus \$2 per \$100 or part thereof up to \$5000. Delivery confirmation is \$2-50. (9) **All material consigned to the Western Australia Study Group for sale is at the Vendor's risk until sold. All material sold becomes the purchaser's risk from time of sale.** (10) Consignments by Vendors and signed bid sheets will be deemed to constitute acceptance of conditions numbered 1 to 9.
