

Because no stamps were punctured OS between June 1914 and May 1917 there were occasional shortages at some WA country offices.

The combined registration and postage rate until 27 October 1918 was 4d.

½d War Tax was introduced on 28 October 1918 but no 4½d stamp issued until 1924.



The Post Office tolerated a low level of trafficking in mint perforated stamps but, when this increased after the issue of overprinted OS stamps, the Commonwealth ceased issuing official stamps in 1933.

The letter rate was raised to 2d on 4 August 1930, registration remained 3d. The covers further illustrate what seems to have been the practice in WA departments to issue letter and registration rate stamps but not the combined letter/registration rate 5d stamp.
