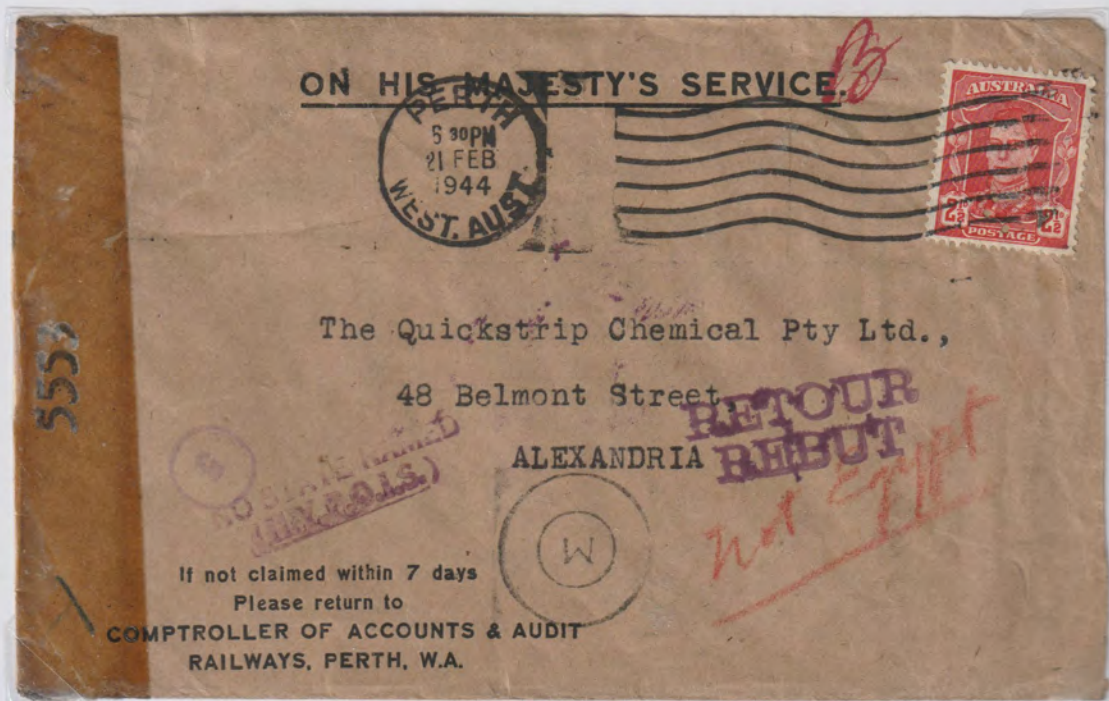

Private Perfins

"To prevent the purloining of postage stamps by employees of business firms etc., such stamps may be perforated with the initials of the firm etc., so as to render their improper sale a matter of difficulty... permission must first be obtained from the PMG." Postal Guide for Western Australia 1900, Section IX/7
Two firms are known to have ordered perfin machines from Sloper in London in 1895.

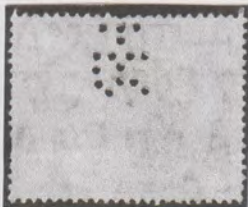
