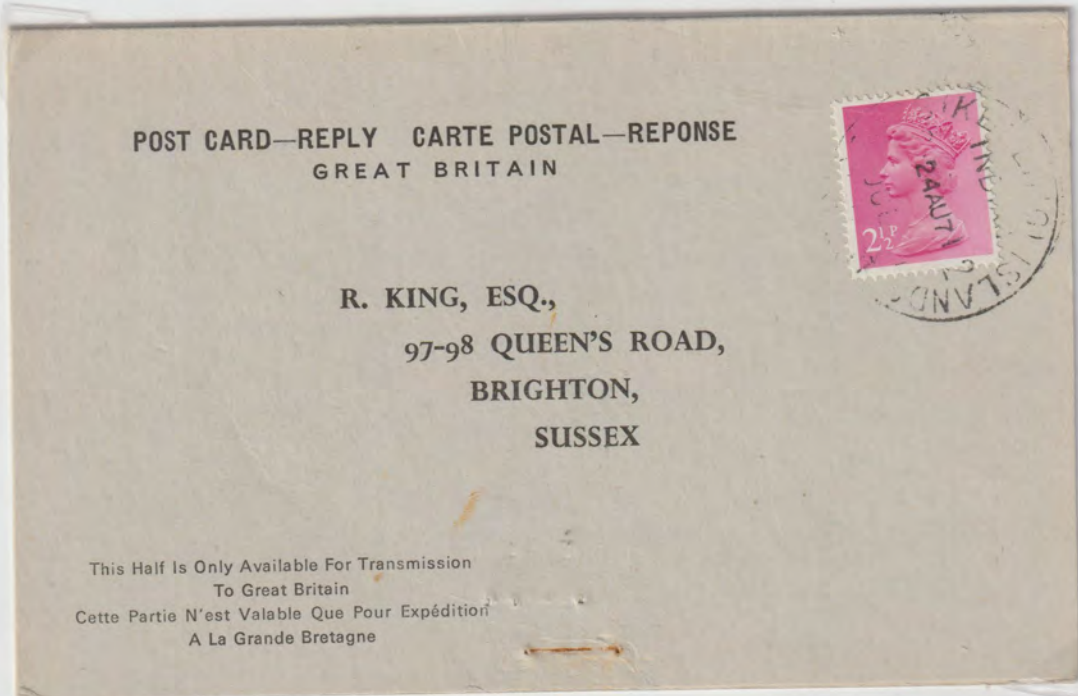

Hove 7 June 1971.

Manuscript 'American Yacht Firebird', PAQUEBOT marking said to be Cocos (Keeling) Islands but no postmark. As the Ships stamps were issued on 29 March 1976 and the eighteen cents rate ended on 30 June 1976, this cover must have been posted between those dates.

AUSTRALIAN TAKEOVER 1974

Following a United Nations intervention in 1974, the Clunies Ross Estate was purchased by the Commonwealth and Cocos became part of Australia Post's Western Australian postal administration. The registration labels were reworded to reflect that change. Registration label Cocos Island West Australia, Cocos (Keeling) Islands 3 Indian Ocean 14 August 1979

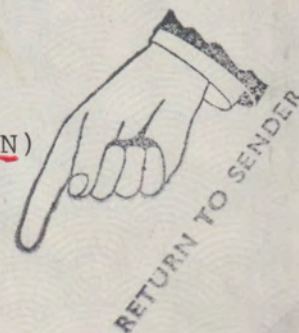

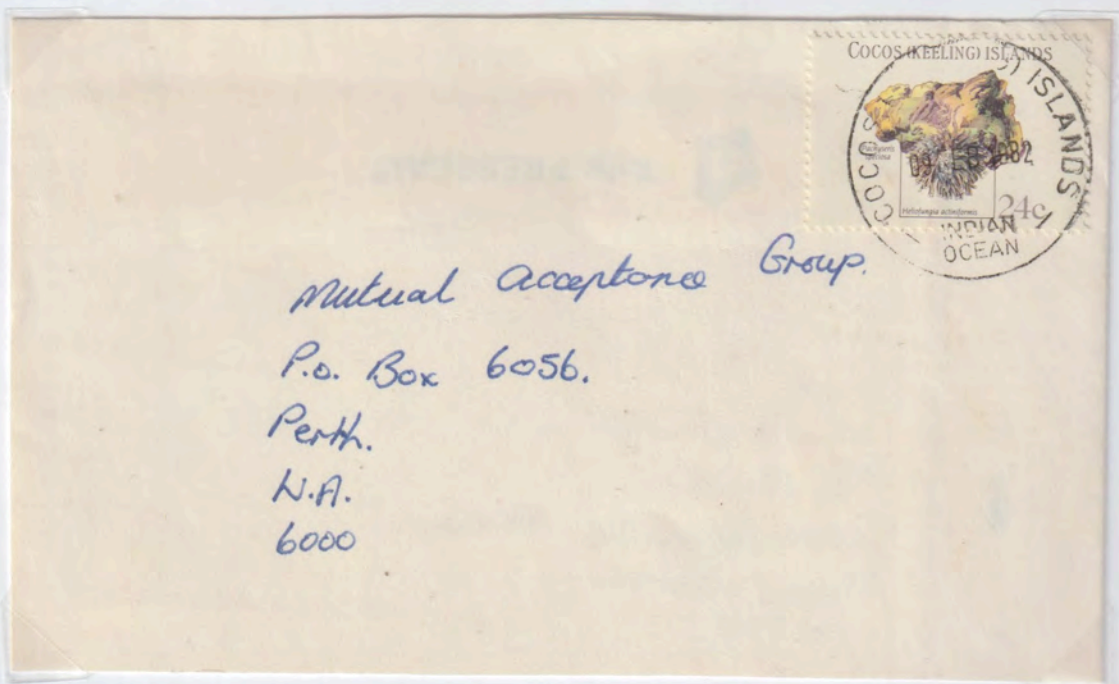
AUSTRALIAN POSTAL RATES
